

Four things to be mindful of as a follower of Christ as a member of a local church as we commit to being ON MISSION.

1. **See the Command**—Biblical—Matthew 28:18-20
2. **Obey the Call**—Divine—2 Timothy 1:9
3. **Face the Challenge**—difficult—John 15:18
4. **Rest in Christ**—possible—Matthew 19:26; Philippians 4:13
