

Malachi 4:1-6

“A Day Is Coming”

The book of Malachi is letter that has within it eight questions from the Israelites directed towards God. With each of these questions, God replies back through the prophet Malachi. Sadly the questions are either filled with accusation against God or justification for themselves and their actions, which are far from the will of God.

As we come to chapter four we find God wearied with His people and He wraps up His word to them with what is to come for them if they will not turn from their sin and turn, in obedient faith, back to God. In these six verses Malachi tells the people, God’s people, of the “day” to come, a day that will culminate in the coming of the Lord who will vilify the wicked and vindicate the righteous, this coming Lord, through the revelation of God’s mystery in the Gospel, is none other than Jesus Christ.
